

SNOWMOBILE SAFETY

When you go out and enjoy the powdery trail on your snowmobile, it is important to keep the following in mind:

- Keep updated on local rules and regulations where you intend to use your snowmobile
- Wear protective gear, helmet and gloves, goggles, long pants, and boots.
- Carry an extra belt, sparkplugs, tow rope, tool kit, flashlight, first aid kit, blanket, and compass
- Check that it is in proper running conditions.
- Avoid trees, shrubs, and wildlife.
- Safe travel speed for maximum control.
- Do not go on snowmobile alone.
- Use headlights at all times.
- Exercise hand signals and stop at all intersections.
- **DO NOT CROSS OVER FROZEN WATER!**
- Take a snowmobile driving and safety course.
