

Power Tool Safety

Always familiarize yourself with your project and what tools you will need to use and read all manufacturer instructions.

- Keep property stored in good, clean condition.
- Provide adequate lighting for you to see.
- Keep work area clean and clean up after each use.
- Dress properly; avoid dangling or hanging clothing or jewelry.
- Wear safety goggles.
- Electrical tools should be double-insulated by 3 wire cords- ground wire connected.
- Never use power tools in wet or damp areas.
- Never unplug cord by pulling cord.
- Do not carry tool by cord.
- Replace all cracked, frayed and damaged cords.
- Always unplug and turn off tool when done, changing accessories, cleaning, or repairing.
