

Propane Grill Safety

4 out of 5 families own a grill and most barbeque on it at least 2 times a week. Following these simple tips can insure that your use of the BBQ is a savory and enjoyable meal.

- Always follow manufacturer's instructions.
- Keep the top open when lighting the grill.
- Always use and store cylinders in upright (vertical) position.
- Check cylinders tank for dents, rust and leaks when refilling.
- Before connecting or lighting propane gas, use leak detection solution to check for connections.
Do not use lighter or matches.
- After filling cylinder take home immediately and keep valve capped and closed.
- Keep children away from grill.
- Do not smoke by grill.
- Do not store space cylinders near heat or high temperature appliances.
- In case of emergency call your local fire department.
- Clean grill grates after every use.
- When not in use, cover grill and disconnect hose and fittings.
