

# ATV SAFETY

To help keep you protected while enjoying your ATV on the open trails please keep in mind:

- Ask your ATV salesman about the local laws and regulations for the area you intend to use your ATV.
- Read your owner's manual and be familiar with your Quad.
- Wear protective gear including, but not limited to- helmet, eye protection, jacket, long pants, boots and gloves.
- ALWAYS check that your ATV is properly running and that the lights, controls, fuel, oil, chain, switches, driveshaft, tires and chassis are functioning properly. This can be controlled by keeping up on regular servicing.
- Make sure you have proper insurance, registration and license.
- DO NOT USE ON PUBLIC ROADS!
- Maintain a controllable speed.
- Practice safe riding and DO NOT drive if you are under the influence of drugs or alcohol, or you are feeling tired or ill.
- Never go out alone.
- Take a training course.
